- Improve access to and availability of transportation services

- Offer support for distinctive projects and initiatives for clubs and other special interest groups of Green Valley Recreation, Inc.

BRIEF HISTORY & DEVELOPMENT OF GVR FOUNDATION

- Established in 2015 from desire of GVR Board to support activities that directly affect GVR members, Green Valley residents, and special needs of our community
- Established and maintains relationship with the Greater Green Valley Community Foundation (GGVCF) using their expertise to set administrative functions; received 2015 grant for strategic planning
- Repaid \$15,000 GVR start-up loan in 2016 early with interest (\$787.50)
- Reached resource sharing agreement between GVR and GVR Foundation (four levels of review: GVR legal counsel, non-profit tax attorney, independent CPA auditor, & insurance specialist)
- Restructured GVR Foundation Board to include two GVR 'Appointed Directors' (2017)
- Received matching grant (\$12,500) from GGVCF to establish an endowment to support sustainability of RetireArizona.org website (2017)
- Amended and Restated Bylaws of GVR Foundation (2017)
- Received \$116,000 in grants between 2015-2017 from GGVCF, Freeport-McMoRan Foundation, The Country Fair White Elephant, and Walmart. Grants supported MAP, Southern Arizona Senior Games and RetireArizona.org website development.

2018 GVR FOUNDATION GOALS

- Continue to develop RetireArizona.org website and implement financial sustainability strategies
- Conduct an Annual Giving Campaign
- Develop a Capital Campaign for a GVR Pickleball Center
- Determine future GVR Foundation staffing needs
- Continue development of donation and giving policies

HIGHLIGHTS OF GVR FOUNDATION PROGRAMS & ACTIVITIES

- **Capital Fundraising Campaign for GVR Pickleball Center**
In March 2018, GVR Board and GVR Foundation Board signed an 'Agreement in Support of Capital Campaign' to jointly support development of a GVR Pickleball Center.
- **Member Assistance Program (MAP)**
GVR Foundation assumed responsibility for MAP in 2015 to help alleviate financial stress of GVR members in need. Thanks to individual donations and a grant from the Country Fair White Elephant, MAP provided \$19,966.50 to assist 45 members in paying annual dues in 2018. We continue to fundraise for the MAP Endowment.
- **RetireArizona.org Website**
Launched in January 2018, this exciting new website promotes the Greater Green Valley community. Made possible by generous start-up grants from the Freeport-McMoRan Foundation, the community-wide website enhances economic development and tourism in and around Green Valley.
- **Southern Arizona Senior Games**
Annual three-week event in March for adults 50+ features more than 30 different sports and recreation competitions, attracting 1,000 participants (approx.) and volunteers from 37 U.S. States, Canada and Mexico. GVR Foundation assumed responsibility for the Senior Games in 2015, with GVR the Presenting Sponsor.
- **SoAZ CultureFest**
Annual celebration in March of people, music, art & food of Southern Arizona, including interactive performances. Proceeds benefit GVR Foundation & Great Green Valley Community Foundation.
- **Write-A-Will Workshops**
Complimentary programs sponsored by GVR Foundation & GGVCF and presented by expert estate planners and financial advisors about how to prepare or revise wills and manage an estate for charitable giving. Two sessions were held in March 2018 for 75 participants with a 'Thank You' reception for participants following the programs.
